In addition, **Renew** clings perfectly to the body, moulding the contours without restricting and improving the athletic performance of those wearing a garment made with this latest generation technical fabric. Extremely comfortable, **Renew** is suitable both for use in the competition swimwear sector and in that more sophisticated and fashionable, where JL has always, and continues to make a name for itself.
